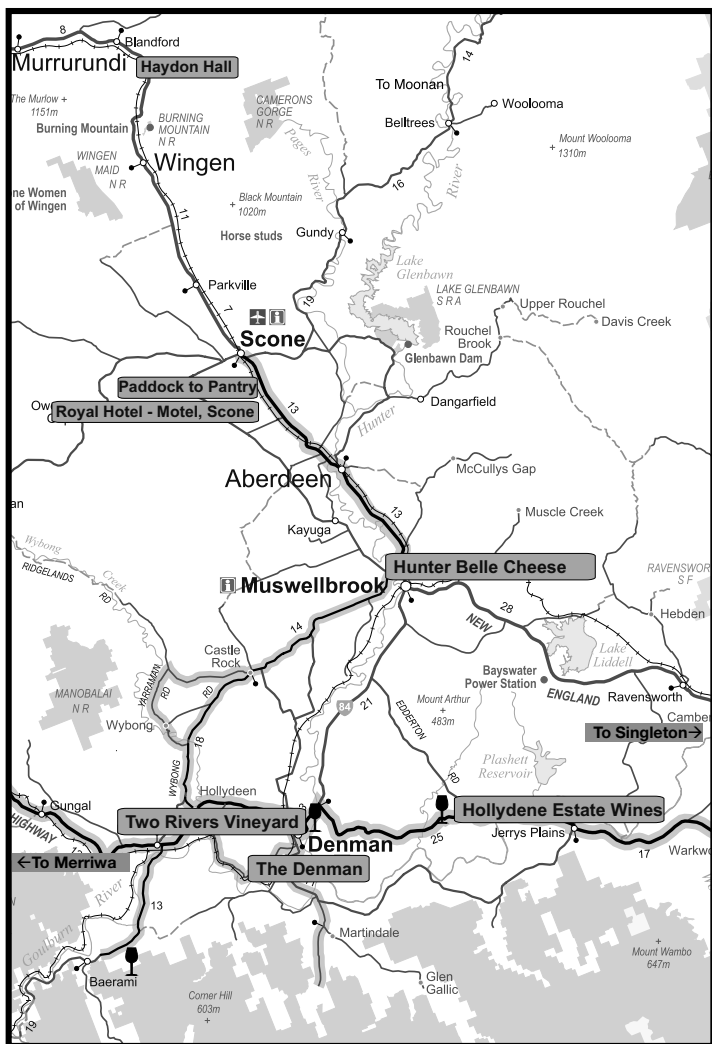

## Flying-foxes camp in Murrurundi

Residents should avoid contact with flying-foxes dead or alive, wash their hands if they are in contact with flying fox faeces and do not allow horses to graze in the area. Residents' views on the flying-foxes are being sought in order to create a camp management plan for the Shire.

A flying-fox camp has landed in Murrurundi at the 'Blue Hole' on the Pages River. Upper Hunter Shire Council is encouraging residents to avoid contact with the animals and to fill in a survey to assist in creating a flying-fox camp management plan for the Shire.

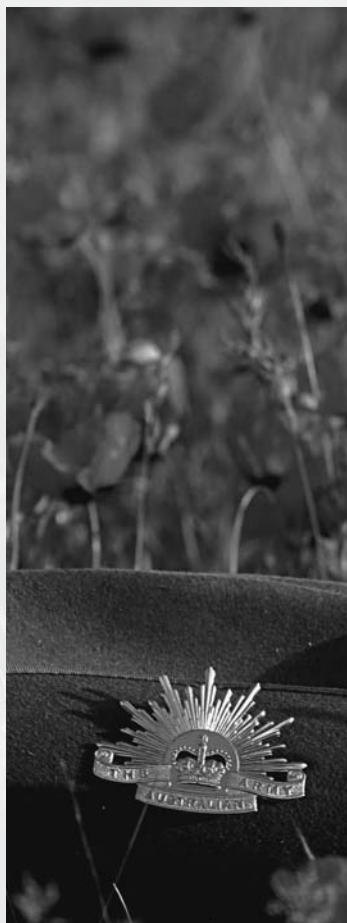
